Missouri Baptist University has reviewed your diploma and associate degree programs and has determined that we are able to accept Hickey College credit toward completion of a Missouri Baptist University bachelor's degree. Credit will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis and awarded in the manner that is most beneficial to the student. MBU has several baccalaureate degree options available and the total number of credits accepted in transfer will vary based on the degree and program pursued by the student. As a result the maximum number of transfer credits that may be accepted can range from 70 to a maximum of 96. Missouri Baptist University baccalaureate degrees require 120 - 128 total hours to complete dependent on the degree and program pursued. Applicants must meet all admission requirements for the intended degree program. This agreement will be in effect from June 30, 2017, until withdrawn or revised by the Missouri Baptist University Provost and Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs.
